President's Beat – Earl Percy

Why are only 5% of Smolts returning?



20 years ago out of 100 smolts leaving the rivers in the UK as many as 25 would return to the river as adult salmon to spawn and further the development of the species. Today, as few as 5 will return. This phenomenon, in various degrees, is being experienced around the North Atlantic. The Atlantic Salmon Trust has done some great work over the last 50 years but we now have to work with a greater level of urgency and find out what is happening out at sea.

As part of our 50th Celebrations we are holding a scientific symposium and bringing scientists, anglers and statisticians together to further a co-ordinated approach to research into The Wild Atlantic Salmon in the Marine Environment. This research is to be welcomed but it is expensive. To preserve this amazing fish for future generations we need resources and I would ask for everyone who is interested in Atlantic Salmon to help in any way they can.

The Chairman's Cast – Robbie Douglas Miller



Our President, George Percy, has asked the key question - Why are less than 5% of smolts leaving our rivers returning as adult salmon?

If we can understand more about the pressure points during a salmon's long journey out to the Atlantic feeding grounds and back, we can try to implement management solutions that can help. For 50 years, the AST have successfully spent time, money and expertise identifying and addressing some of the most important freshwater problems. We now want to move further afield and look at impacts in the tidal zone and the open ocean. Like any successful organisation, it is down to the team to deliver on the objectives. My job as Chairman is largely to make sure the team is up to the job and the funds are in place to enable our work.

The Board of Trustees – are a group of 10 individuals with a range of skill sets that are motivated to deliver the Trusts objectives. They give their time for free, set the strategy and ensure every Pound donated is wisely spent.

The Honorary Scientific Advisory Panel – A carefully selected group of scientists who review and validate the research programme of the Trust to ensure that projects are viable before they are commissioned and written up when they are completed.

The Executive Management Team – The organisation is led by Chief Executive, Sarah Bayley Slater and the Science Research by Professor Ken Whelan. Their job is to deliver on the strategy as set by the Trustees and to have their work reviewed by the HSAP.

The newly focussed Atlantic Salmon Trust has set itself a very challenging objective. The 50th anniversary Gala Celebrations are very much a launch pad for this work. We need your help.

The Chief Executive's Take

Sarah Bayley Slater

The AST is using the significant milestone of its 50th Anniversary to raise awareness of the plight of the wild Atlantic salmon and draw focus on the question:

Why are as few as 5% of smolts leaving our rivers returning as adult salmon?

The AST's aim is to gather the information to improve our understanding of the causes of this decline. It is possible to make assumptions but actual quantified data and evidence of the problems allows us to work out the most effective solutions. To operate within a defined strategy and to co-ordinate our research around the Atlantic we are developing The Suspects Model which our Research Director describes on page 7.

To assess the impact of some of the Likely Suspects that could be contributing towards the salmon's decline the AST are focussing on 3 key areas:

Suspect 1: "Do smolts die in large quantities in the lower river and coastal zone and, if so, why?"

Project: Acoustic Telemetry Tracking

To get a clear understanding of what is happening to smolts during their migration the AST is developing a Tracking Programme for smolts, to monitor their progress towards the open ocean. Dr. Matt Newton has just been appointed as Acoustic Tracking project Co-ordinator for the AST.



Suspect 2: "What are the effects of the pelagic fishing fleet on salmon smolts at sea?"

Project: Environmental DNA (eDNA)

Understanding pelagic by-catch
For some time there has been concern about the level of accidental killing of salmon by pelagic vessels at sea during their migration from and to their rivers of origin.

Using environmental DNA (eDNA), the AST and University College Dublin are running an innovative project to develop and pilot a pioneering technique to assess the presence or absence of salmon DNA fragments on board fishing boats.

Suspect 3: "How can we reduce the impacts of salmon aquaculture?"

Project: To work with the Aquaculture industry to reduce its effect on migrating wild salmon and sea trout.

In light of the recent scientific information on the impacts of Aquaculture the AST has revised and updated its positioning statement on salmon aquaculture. We are finding ways to urgently and positively move forward the dialogue with the fish farming industry and Government so as to alter fish farm management practices and improve conditions for wild salmon and sea trout.

Chief Executive's Take

The problems facing salmon and sea trout in the marine environment are significant and it requires focus, energy, determination and strong partnerships to put together a program which addresses the issues at sea. Our aim is, over the next 10 years, to understand the reasons for mortality in migrating salmon and sea trout and through this understanding develop the tools and strategies to address them. Atlantic Salmon Dying at Sea – The Likely Suspects

It's hard to believe that only a decade ago we were preparing to make our first concerted international efforts to follow wild salmon across the Atlantic, to learn more about migration and distribution patterns and to begin the process of identifying where and why our salmon are dying at sea. The Atlantic Salmon Trust was to the fore in providing funding for the initiative and as the story of salmon at sea unfolded the AST has, through its funding of research, become more and more involved with the mysteries surrounding the losses of salmon in the ocean.

A decade of research has revealed that a range of likely suspects may be impacting on migrating smolts and post-smolts. Studies on the growth, condition and survival of salmon at sea indicated a link with climate change, particularly the warming of the surface layers of the oceans, the very environment through which young salmon or smolts, migrate northwards towards their feeding grounds. The SALSEA project identified post-smolts captured at sea to their river of origin and led to the concept of an annual conveyor belt of northward



migrating smolts. Along this route, the number of post-smolts declines due to cumulative effects of natural mortality as well as any man-made influences, such as fishing mortality in the form of by-catch. With the help of Professor Walter Crozier and through collaboration with our partners around the Atlantic, the AST is currently developing the concept of a mathematical "likely suspects" model to seek to quantify the relative (and absolute) importance of each of the candidate mortality factors; where exactly are most of the smolts dying and where should we concentrate our efforts in ensuring that the maximum number of smolts reach the feeding grounds.

Our only means of off-setting high seas mortality is boosting the numbers of wild smolts and post-smolts surviving at sea. The lesson we must learn is that man's influence can and does have an impact on these struggling populations. Management actions have historically taken place in freshwater, but the emphasis is now moving to the coastal zone and the open ocean. This is in line with the three projects our Chief Executive Sarah Bayley Slater has described on the previous page. The current research objective is to commission projects which are guided by the Suspects Model. This will then feed back into the model and provide us with a foundation for future research, particularly on factors where management action can make a difference. AST believes that our challenge is to reduce or at least mitigate the man-made pressures currently on the populations at risk so as to give them time and space to adapt and to recover. A new and exciting phase of research on salmon at sea is about to unfold.

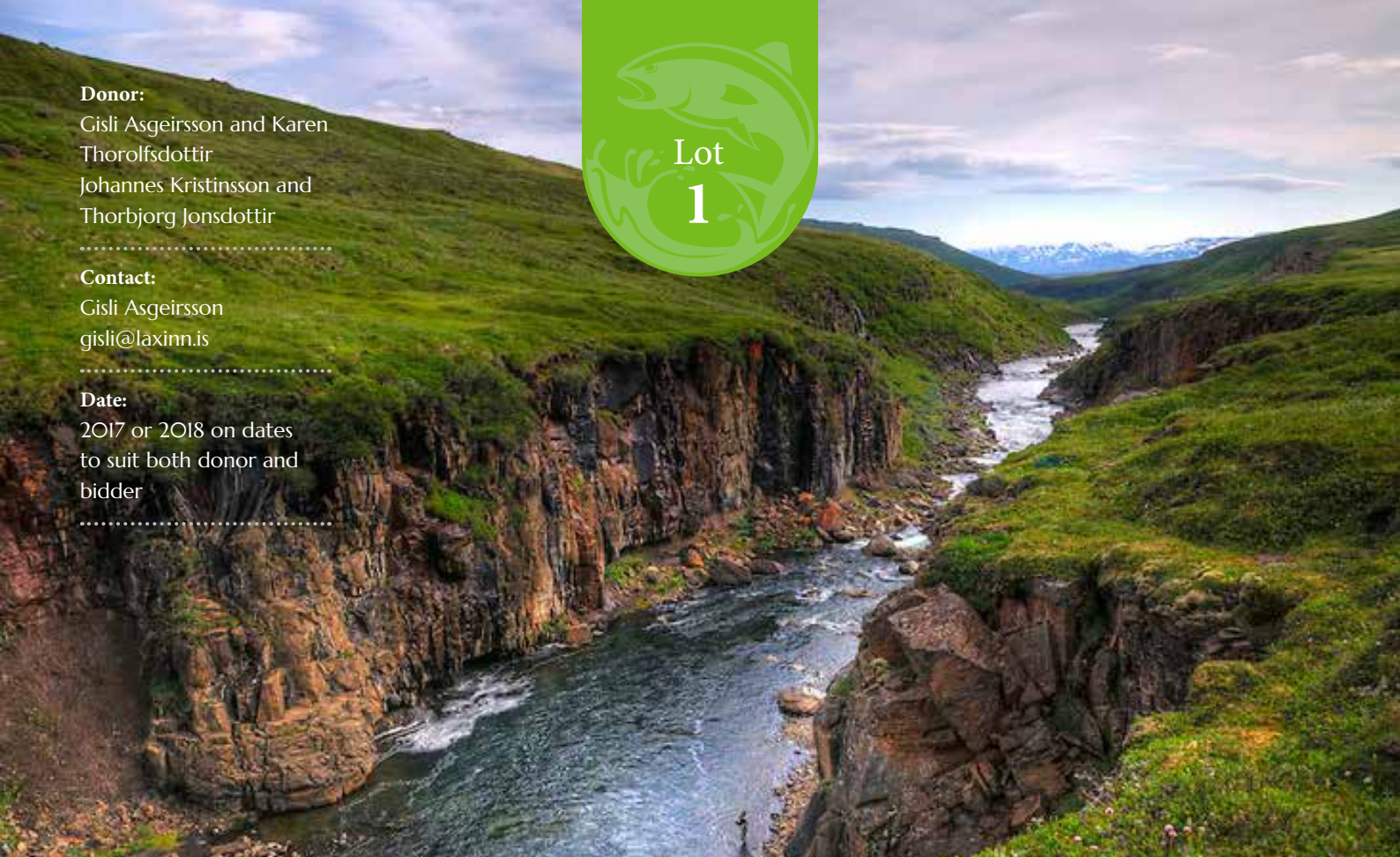

Hofsa is a strict fly only and catch and release river. It is one of the Icelandic elite rivers and so consumes its visitors that they wish to come back at the earliest available opportunity. It has a long canyon on the top beats, a dramatic impassable falls and a string of



challenging pools as the river thunders down the canyon. But once the canyon ends, the river turns into an almost endless string of long slow flowing pools, each one seeming more enticing and inviting than the last one!

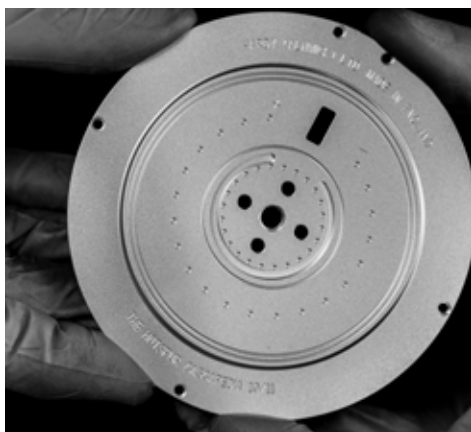

Raising funds for The AST Acoustic Tracking Programme

Acoustic Tracking – How you can help tracking smolts.

Acoustic Tracking is one of the Atlantic Salmon Trust's key science projects. With funding from the Fishmongers' Company, the Trust has recently employed a project Co-ordinator – Dr. Matt Newton.

The backbone to any tracking study, are the tags (£350 each), attached to the fish and receivers (£4,000 each), which detect the fish as they migrate through the river systems. Vemco, one of the manufacturers of tracking equipment, have donated to the AST a single receiver. We urgently need to build on this generous gift and to purchase 50 tags costing £17,500. This would enable the AST to start building a bank of equipment to support a project(s) uncovering the behaviour of migrating salmonids.

THE LAST CAST TROPHY SALMON TO COMMEMORATE THE 50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE ATLANTIC SALMON TRUST

The Atlantic Salmon Trust asked Silvy Weatherall if she could come up with a design to articulate the current plight of this amazing Fish in its 50th Anniversary Year.

The winding river is strategically placed where the fish produces spawn. The Smolts are running down the River out to sea and out of 100 leaving for the migration only 4 Adult Salmon (less than 5) are returning. The migration is being affected by Predators (the heron), Aquaculture, (cages on the spine) and the Worlds Fishing Fleet (trawler on the dorsal fin). The spiral motif on the head signifies human awareness of energy and nature itself.

The History of the Trust

In 1967 The Atlantic Salmon Trust was founded, against a backdrop of growing concerns over the excessive numbers of wild salmon being taken by distant water fisheries, and the impact of UDN (Ulcerative Dermal Necrosis). It was distinctive in being one of the first organisations devoted to the welfare of a single species, and quickly demonstrated its effectiveness in raising awareness of the plight of salmon. Over the years, AST's role has widened to include sea trout.

Throughout its life, AST has depended heavily on its Honorary Scientific Advisory Panel – a group of the finest scientists in the field, who give their time free of charge to advise on and suggest areas of research which we can support, and to guide our policy. This has meant that we have been able to punch well above our weight in terms of influencing politicians and regulators – both within the British Isles and further afield. The HSAP remains pre-eminent in the role of the Trust today. Prior to the arrival of RAFTS (Rivers & Fisheries Trusts Scotland) and the Rivers Trust, AST was the only conservation charity working on behalf of wild Atlantic

Salmon. The Trust's biologist performed an irreplaceable role on the riverbank, responding to concerns of managers, biologists, owners and anglers throughout the UK in advising managers on the river bank. This led to many successes. By 2009, with the Fishery Trusts well and truly up and running, AST felt that a role for its biologist had ceased to exist.

Highlights of AST's entire lifetime have been the many conferences and workshops which we have organised, in specialist areas such as the welfare of sea trout, importance of river flows, and the role which small streams play in recruitment of salmon and sea trout. Today much of this work is carried out by the individual River Boards and Trusts.

Our focus has now moved to the Marine Environment. There are many battles yet to be won. Our ultimate aim remains the same today as it was in 1967: Putting Wild Salmon First. All of our scientific work feeds into understanding how we can improve the mortality rate of migrating Smolts so more adult Salmon will return to UK and Irish Rivers.
